Collection Description

Biographical and Historical Note

E. (Eugene) Clayton Calhoun, Jr., Methodist minister, educator, and missionary, was born on November 18, 1912 in Douglas, Georgia to the Reverend Eugene Clayton Calhoun, Sr., and Minerva Augusta Barnes Calhoun; he spent his early life in northern Florida. He was married to Frankie S. Morgan of Pembroke, Georgia on May 12, 1935. Calhoun died on December 31, 2009

in Asheville, North Carolina. He received his undergraduate degree from Florida Southern College, his seminary degree from Perkins School of Theology/Southern Methodist University, and did further graduate studies at the University of California at Berkeley, and Boston University. After being ordained as a deacon into the ministry of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, and as an elder in the Methodist Church, he served as pastor to churches in North Carolina, Texas, and Florida. He was a missionary to China before and after World War II (1940 and 1946); served as president of Paine College from 1956 to 1970; as director of the Black College Fund of the United Methodist Church in Nashville, Tennessee until 1974; founded the Smoky Mountain Center for Independent Studies (Clyde, North Carolina), a retreat for small college and church groups; and wrote the book, Of Men Who Ventured Much and Far, 1961. He retired as a United Methodist minister in 1974 in Asheville, North Carolina.
