

## **Paine College Announces 2026 Commencement and Reunion Weekend Activities**

AUGUSTA, GA — Paine College proudly announces its 2026 Commencement and Reunion Weekend, scheduled for Thursday, May 7 through Saturday, May 9, 2026. This event is invitation-only and will recognize individuals whose generosity continues to advance the College's mission.

Commencement exercises will take place on Saturday, May 9, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the HEAL Complex. Family, friends, faculty, and staff will gather to celebrate the accomplishments of the graduating class. Immediately following the ceremony, graduates will participate in the distribution of degrees from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the HEAL Complex Large Classroom.

The weekend will conclude with a College Cookout from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Peters Campus Center Veranda and Grounds, offering a relaxed and festive atmosphere for the Paine community to celebrate together.

As part of Reunion Weekend 2026, Paine College will recognize alumni from classes ending in "1" and "6." Alumni are encouraged to pre-register to take advantage of discounted rates, which include a commemorative reunion polo and tickets to select events.
